

Mountain hike in Abisko

Available June 17 - Sept 25 2022

Rates valid May 1 2022- April 30 2023

Join us on a hike in the mountains close to Abisko nationalpark, learning about the nature in the area.

We take the lift up to Aurora sky station and mount Nuolja and walk with an amazing view down to the Abisko valley or, if you have hard to walk down hill we take the chairlift down to the valley again after a short walk on the mountain.



After a 1,5 hour drive by car, we enter Abisko national park. From here we take the chairlift up to mount Nuolja and Aurora sky station.

20 minutes with the lift and we are over the tree border. We walk at mount Nuolja enjoying the stunning landscape while our local Sami guide tells about the nature, Sami culture and stories from the area.

In a nice location we stop to have a cup of tea before we go down to the Abisko valley, where we eat lunch in the restaurant. After the meal we drive back to Kiruna.

Price: SEK 1 890/pers. Children SEK 990/child 3-15 year. Private group SEK 6 290, max 3 adults or 2 adults + 2 children. Extra participant SEK 1 890/pers.

Included in the price: Transfer from your hotel 20 km around Kiruna, tour with the lift up mount Nuolja if open, tea, lunch and Sami guide. We recommend warm clothes for the season, gloves, mittens and a good hat.

Participants: Minimum 2 adults, max 8. Bigger groups on request.

Departures: 08.00-15.00, the time is approximate. The tour is available June 17 to September 25.
