Learn how Sami people dress, how to find the right wood for your fire and get knowledge about what you can eat at different times of the year. Learn how to manage the arctic life and prepare to enjoy your visit in the north.

Out in the forest, winter or summer, the only way to survive is to keep warm. We teach you traditional knowledge, the Sami way of being in nature, how to think, what to do and not do and we learn how to dress, make a fire and find food.

We look for the food that is possible to find for the season, look for animal tracks and learn ways to move in the forest. Everything so that you yourself feel safe out in nature.

We will walk in the forest, we adapt the tour for your skills, but it is good if you can walk in nature max 1 km.

Price: SEK 1,690/adult. Children SEK 1,090/child, 6-15 year. Private tour SEK 6,990, max 3 adults, alt 2 adults + 2 children, also children under 6 years. Add on extra participants SEK 1,690/person.

The price includes: Pick-up from new Kiruna C or Camp Ripan, Sami guide, cover clothes and shoes, hot drink and a cake.

Participants: Minimum 2 adults, max 16. (normally 8 pers/guide) Bigger groups and other times on request.

Departures: Daily tours Oct 1 - May 15, 08.00-12.00.

We recommend good clothes adapted to the season, a good hat and gloves.
