We hike in the Abisko area and visit Abisko canyon and the portal to the Kings trail.

After a one hour drive by car, we eat a three-course dinner in the restaurant in Abisko. Our local guide tells about nature, Sami culture and stories from the area.

After dinner we provide you with camera equipment and go for a walk in the magical evening light to explore nature with photography.

We walk in Abisko National Park, photograph the beautiful landscape and visit Abisko canyon and the portal of Kings trail.

If you want to stay in Abisko/Björkliden after the tour, you pay extra to bring your luggage.

**Price:** SEK 2,590/adult. Children 10-15 years SEK 1,590/child. Private tour SEK 6,990 max 2 pers, additional participants SEK 2,590/pers. Luggage fee for drop off in Abisko/Björkliden SEK 400/booking.

**Included in the price:** Pick-up from Icehotel, Kiruna tourist office and Camp Ripan, three-course dinner, camera equipment and Sami photo guide. We recommend warm clothes adapted for the season.

**Participants:** Min 2 adults, max 8. Bigger groups or other dates on request.

**Departure:** 17.00-approx. 22.30. June 1 - August 31.

Beverage and SD memory card not included. Children share camera with parents.
