

Lunch tour to the Sami village Nikkaluokta

Follow us to Nikkaluokta, a small Sami village in the beautiful high mountain area, near Kebnekaise, Sweden's highest mountain.

Hike in the mountain area and learn more about Sami people and the arctic nature while enjoying the beautiful landscape.

Our local Sami guide will pick you up at your hotel and, by minibus, we drive to the village. We enjoy the fantastic landscape, with the opportunity to see moose, reindeer and other wild animals, and also make a stop to see Mount Kebnekaise when it is possible to see it.

The road ends in the Nikkaluokta village and from here the hiking will start. We walk in the valley near the village and enjoy the high mountains close to the river Vistasjohka and the large lake Báittasjávri. We also visit the small chapel and your guide teach you about Sami people and the arctic nature.

Before we go back to Kiruna we have lunch, outdoors or indoors depending on weather.

Price: SEK 1,890/adult. Children 3-15 years SEK 1,290/child. Private tour SEK 6,990, max 2 persons. Extra participant SEK 1,890/person. Luggage fee for drop off in Nikkaluokta SEK 300/booking.

Included in the price: Pick-up from Icehotel, new Kiruna C or Camp Ripan, Sami guide, lunch, cover clothes and shoes on request, booster seats for children.

We recommend warm clothes adapted for the season, gloves and a hat.

Participants: Minimum 2 adults. Bigger groups and other times on request.

Departure: 09.00- approx 14.00.
