

Lunch tour to the Sami village Nikkaluokta

Follow us to Nikkaluokta, a small Sami village in the beautiful high mountain area, near Kebnekaise, Sweden's highest mountain.

We do a light hike in the mountain area, or a walk in the village, and learn more about Sami people and the arctic nature while enjoying the beautiful landscape.

Join our local Sami guide for a day visit to Nikkaluokta to learn more about the arctic nature, Sami culture and history of the area. On our drive to Nikkaluokta we enjoy the fantastic landscape, with the opportunity to see moose, reindeer and other wild animals, and also make a stop to see Mount Kebnekaise, Sweden's highest mountain, when it is possible to see it.

In summer and autumn we do a light hike, visit Nikkaluokta chapel and have lunch in the Sami-owned restaurant, in winter and spring we walk in the village and visit our guide's home for a Sami activity and lunch.

After this day tour in Nikkaluokta, you will know more about the daily nowadays life of Sami people, had a great full-day experience, both outdoor and indoor, and hopefully you got to see moose.

Price: SEK 2,190/adult. Children SEK 1,390/child, 3-15 years. Private tour SEK 8,990, max 2 persons. Extra participant SEK 2,190/person. Luggage fee for drop off in Nikkaluokta or Kiruna airport SEK 500/booking.

Included in the price: Pick-up from Icehotel, Kiruna tourist office or Camp Ripan, Sami guide, lunch and booster seats for children. Cover clothes and shoes on request.

We recommend warm clothes adapted to the season, gloves and a hat.

Participants: Minimum 2 adults. Bigger groups and other times on request.

Departure: 9.00am- approx 2.00pm. Daily tours.
