

Mountain hike in Abisko

Join us on a hike in the mountains near Abisko National Park, learning about nature in the area.

We walk in the beautiful Abisko valley and enjoy the landscape. When the chairlift is open, we go up to the Aurora sky station and Mount Nuolja and hike from there. We end the tour with lunch in Abisko valley.



After a 1,5 hour drive by car, we enter Abisko national park, where we begin our hike. If the chair lift is open, we go up to Mount Nuolja and Aurora sky station to start our hike there.

We walk in the national park enjoying the stunning landscape while our local Sami guide tells about nature, Sami culture and stories from the area.

At a nice location we stop for a cup of tea before going back to eat lunch in Abisko village. After the meal we drive back to Kiruna.

If you want to stay in Abisko/Björkliden after the tour, you have to pay extra to bring your luggage.

Price: SEK 1,890/pers. Children SEK 1,290/child 3-15 years. Private tour SEK 6,990, max 3 adults or 2 adults + 2 children. Extra participant SEK 1,890/pers. Luggage fee for drop off in Abisko/Björkliden SEK 400/booking.

Included in the price: Pick-up from Icehotel, Kiruna tourist office or Camp Ripan, ride with the lift up Mount Nuolja if open, tea, lunch, booster seats for children and Sami guide. We recommend warm clothes adapted for the season, gloves and a hat.

Participants: Min 2 adults, max 8.

Departures: 08.00-approx. 14.00. June 15 - Oct 15.
