We hike in the beautiful Abisko national park and enjoy the unique surroundings. Before we drive back, we end the tour with lunch in Abisko valley.

At this full-day hiking tour to Abisko national park, our local Sami guide bring you to one of the most popular hiking areas in the mountains around Kiruna.

We explore the magnificent nature in the Abisko valley, or if the chair lift is open, we go up to Mount Nuolja and Aurora sky station to start our hike there.

We enjoy the landscape, admire the flowering alpine meadows and crystal-clear mountain water in Abisko Canyon, while our guide tells about nature, Sami culture and stories from the area.

Before returning back to Kiruna we eat lunch in Abisko village.

Price: SEK 1,990/pers. Children SEK 1,390/child 3-15 years. Private tour SEK 8,990, max 3 adults or 2 adults + 2 children. Extra participant SEK 1,990/pers. Luggage fee for drop off in Abisko/Björkliden SEK 500/booking.

Included in the price: Pick-up from Icehotel, Kiruna tourist office or Camp Ripan, ride with the lift up Mount Nuolja if open, tea, lunch, booster seats for children and Sami guide. We recommend warm clothes adapted for the season, gloves and a hat.

Participants: Min 2 adults, max 8.

Departures: 8.00am-approx. 2.00pm. June 15 - Oct 15.
