Listen to Sami stories and traditions and learn more about the arctic nature under the Aurora Borealis.

We pick you up and drive to our Sami guides' home area. While we taste Sami traditional specialties our guide shows a slideshow and tells about the arctic nature, Sami culture and Sami traditions.

When the food is ready we eat a Sami family dinner and then we go out to look for the northern lights and learn more about our arctic nature.

If you bring your own camera we will help you to get the right settings and to get pictures from the evening.

If we don't see northern lights we start driving back to increase our chances of seeing auroras.

Price: SEK 2,590/adult. Children SEK 1,590/child, 3-15 year. Private group SEK 12,290 max 2 pers, add on extra participants SEK 2,590/pers, also children younger than 3 years old. Beverage not included.

The price includes: Pick-up from Icehotel, new Kiruna C or Camp Ripan, slideshow, two-course dinner, Sami photo guide, booster seats for children, a headlamp and cover clothes and shoes if needed.

Participants: Minimum 2 adults.

Departure: 17.00-22.30, time is approximate. Tour available Sept 1-March 31. No tour Dec 24 and 31.

We recommend you to prepare with warm clothes for the season, mittens and a hat.
