

We drive by car, in the direction of the day. When we stop the guide helps you get acquainted with the camera. We practice photography in order to be well prepared to take good pictures of landscape, animals and plants during the tour.

We choose our themes depending on the weather and Sami eight seasons and tell Sami knowledge about nature and animals.

We can never guarantee you pictures of, for example, wild animals, but we will search for good nature sceneries, sneak up on arctic animals like moose, reindeer and birds and search for opportunities to photograph what is special for the season. Also the guide will tell about the area. The tour ends with a cup of coffee or tea and a cake.

**Price:** SEK 1,690/adult. Children SEK 1,290/child 8–15 years. Private tour SEK 6,990 max 2 pers, also children younger than 8 years. Additional participants SEK 1,690/pers.

**The price includes:** Pick-up from Icehotel, Kiruna tourist office or Camp Ripan, Sami photo guide, camera with telelens and hot drink and cake.

We recommend warm clothes adapted for the season, gloves and a hat. Cover clothes and shoes on request.

**Participants:** Minimum 2 adults, max 8. Bigger groups or other times on request, also with lunch. (ask price)

**Departure:** Daily tours, pick up in the city 08.30-12.30, pick up Icehotel 08.00–12.00 March 1- Oct 31, in winter 09.00–13.00 Nov 1-Feb 28.

SD memory card not included. Children share camera with parents.
